

VAE coordinates monthly 4 or 5 artist exhibitions in the front gallery. Each artist will have a selection of his/her work exhibited on one of the four walls of the gallery (or pedestals for three-dimensional art), along with vinyl signage and listings on promotional materials, the VAE website and email.

Artist benefits:

- A cohesive, professional looking exhibition of the artist's work in the front retail space of VAE's downtown Raleigh gallery
- An artists' reception on the First Friday of the month
- Vinyl signage of the artist's name below your exhibition
- Artist statement featured in a gallery binder
- Promotional postcards listing the yearly calendar of Exchange Gallery artists
- Artist's name listed on VAE promotional materials and email
- A 'Featured Artist' listing on the VAE website
- A press release sent out about the artist's work

Exchange Gallery Artist responsibilities:

- Volunteer during the month of the artist's exhibit
- \$25 exhibition fee

Eligibility:

The Exchange Gallery is open to all VAE members working in any medium. Sculpture and jewelry artists will be considered separately from two-dimensional artists and are encouraged to apply. Artists who would like to be considered for both 2D and 3D work must submit two separate applications.

Application Deadline: March 17, 2010

How to apply:

To apply send the following materials to VAE by March 17, 2010. Applicants will be notified of the jury's results in early April.

- Application form (attached)
- \$10 application fee
- Artist statement and resume
- 3-5 jpegs of your work (by CD or email) *

*Images or pieces submitted must be representative of the type of work you plan to exhibit.

Digital entries: Artists must submit 3-5 entries in JPEG format on CD or via email to entries@visualartexchange.org. All images submitted by CD MUST be on one CD. Image files must be labeled last name followed by 01, 02, etc. (example: Smith01, Smith 02). All CDs/images must be readable by PC platforms. File sizes cannot exceed 2MB with DPI of at least 72. Images should be oriented correctly. DO NOT submit PowerPoint presentations, automated slide presentations, or work on a DVD. All CDs must be labeled with the artist's name and file names with corresponding artwork titles.
